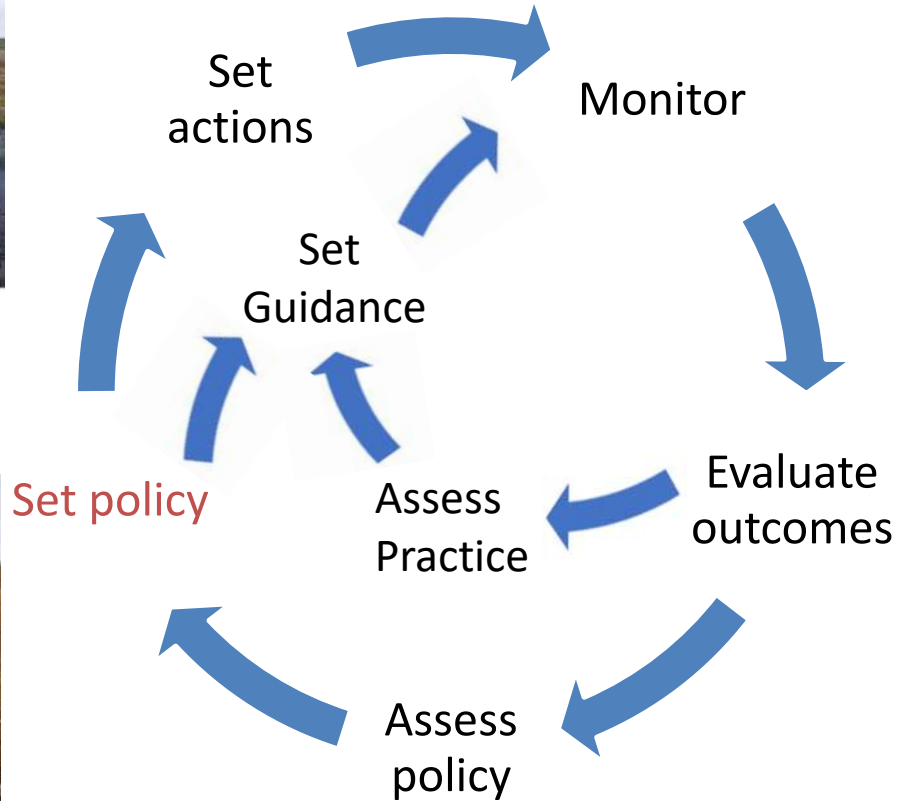


The Futures Bridge
